- **Key Deliverables:**

- Disinfection of ambulances (interior/exterior, stretchers, equipment zones).
- Thorough sanitization and de-cluttering of wards and storage areas
- Post-cleaning evaluation via visual evidence.

Scope & Objectives

- **Areas Covered:**

- Ambulance: [DL1A2478, DL1A2495].
- Stores: [Wards, SNCU].

- **Key Goals:**

1. Minimize cross-contamination risks.
2. Boost readiness for emergency response.
3. Enhance clarity and organization within storage space.

- **Implementation Details:**

- **Ambulances:**

- Interior: high-touch areas (stretcher rails, door handles, seats) wiped with hospital-grade disinfectants.
- Exterior: degreasing and disinfecting surfaces, checking wheels.
- Equipment: Detachable gear sanitized and restocked neatly.

- **Stores:**

- De-cluttering: removal of expired/unserviceable items (with proper condemnation and disposal).
- Organizing: clearly labeled racks, FIFO (First-In-First-Out) adherence.
- Floor-to-ceiling disinfection, with special attention to ventilation and dust-prone corners.
